### **Recipient of personal data:**

Personal data submitted to municipal authorities can become public information and subsequently requested by anyone unless prevented by confidentiality.

### **Storage limitation:**

The municipal executive committee's records management plan regulates how long data is stored before being removed or archived.

### **The data subjects rights:**

The data subject has the right to request transcripts of information, right to rectification of information and, if applicable, erasure of information.

### **How to make a complaint to the regulatory authority:**

The Data Protection Authority (DPA) is a public authority and administers cases concerning personal data processing. To lodge a complaint with the DPA contact the authority directly.
